Distracted Driving

Washington State enacted 1 of the nation's toughest Driving While Under the Influence of Electronics (E-DUI) laws last year.



Under the new law drivers cannot hold electronics (cell phones, tablets, laptops or any handheld electronic devices) while driving or stopped in traffic — even at a stoplight. Other states may follow with similar laws to crack down on drivers who use electronic devices while behind the wheel. Check your state's laws and states where you are traveling. **Best bet:** Put away the electronic devices while you're driving and focus on the road.
